Mamaia is a resort on the Romanian Black Sea shore and a district of Constanța. Considered to be Romania's most popular resort, Mamaia is situated immediately north-east of Constanța's city center. It has almost no full-time residents, being populated mostly during the summer. Mamaia lies on a strip of land 8 km in length and only 300 m in width, between the Black Sea and Lake Siutghiol.

Tournament hall

The venue of the tournament is in Hotel COMANDOR



- Two rooms: 250sqm and 84sqm. In the larger room some curtains will be added to the windows to prevent blinding from outside.
- No of Toilettes: M: 3+5 W: 4. This are not many toilets but it is possible to allocate for the players the both men and women cabins from the 1 floor and for the staff and arbiters the ones at the ground floor.
- Analyzing room on the lower floor

Quality of hotels

HOTEL AMIRAL 4*: Very good, 120 rooms, outside pool. Distance to the beach 50m.

Buffet menu will be served with breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Airport connections

Bucharest Otopeni 240km - 3hrs, €60 (return); Varna 160km, €60 (return); Constanta Airport 34km (free)

Conclusion:
