- other players: 100 PLN lub 25 €

Remark:

European Rapid Chess Championship medallists 2013, female players with ELO rating of at least 2400 and players with ELO rating of at least 2600 on the 1st of November 2014 do not need to pay the entry fee, if registered no later than on the 20th of November 2014.

10. HOTELS

The official tournament hotel is Hotel ORBIS Wroclaw, Wroclaw (ul. Powstancow Slaskich), - 4 km from the playing hall.

I) Single room with a bathroom (including **breakfast**): **210 PLN** (about 50 €) per day.

II) Double room with a bathroom (including **breakfast**): **115 PLN** (about 28 €) per person per day.

III) The organisers will provide free bus transfer from the Orbis Hotel to the playing hall and back for the players staying in the hotel.

11. SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- Free accommodation (from the 19th till the 21st of December 2014) in the 4 stars Wroclaw Hotel (single rooms) for 10 highest rated players registered no later than on the 20th of November 2014.

- Free accommodation (from the 19th till the 21st of December 2014) in the 4 stars Wroclaw Hotel (double rooms) for 10 players seeded 11th-20th registered no later than on the 20th of November 2014.
- Free accommodation (from the 19th till the 21st of December 2014) in the 4 stars Wroclaw Hotel (a single room) for the highest rated woman registered no later than on the 20th of November 2014.
- Free accommodation (from the 19th till the 21st of December 2014) in the 4 stars Wroclaw Hotel (a double room) for the 2nd and 3rd highest rated women registered no later than on the 20th of November 2014.
- The organisers will cover travel expenses (up to 300 € according to the tickets) for 10 highest rated players registered before deadline
- Fee for players with ELO rating 2700 (women with ELO rating 2600) negotiated individually with the director of the tournament info@ecc.wroclaw.pl
