Declaration generally assuring visas to representatives of all federations:

Citizens of EU and almost all European countries, former Soviet Union countries including Russia, Israel and Turkey need no visas. They will get free of charge stamp in Batumi or Tbilisi airport.

Exceptions, if any, and reasons: **Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia. Citizens of Macedonia will get easy online visas in 5 working days for 20 USD.**
