### OFFICIAL REGULATIONS

---

#### 1. PARTICIPATION

---

1.1 Each FIDE Continent, Africa, America, Asia and Europe have the right to nominate one team of 16 players.

1.2 Each team consists of 16 boards (age categories):

- 8 boys - (2 of each U12-U14-U16-U18 categories)
- 8 girls - (2 of each U12-U14-U16-U18 categories)

Participants will be selected by each Continental Chess Association

- 1.3. Each Continent will appoint one captain/representative for the technical meeting and all communications during the event.
- 1.4. There is no entry fee
- 1.5. By signing in the tournament, all participants confirm to have read and accepted these regulations the terms and conditions of this championship.

---

## 2. REGISTRATION

---

- 2.1. Registrations are made by the Continents filling the special registration form and sent it to [eocc@europechess.org](mailto:eocc@europechess.org)
- 2.2. The players are registered by their FIDE rapid rating. In case they don't have then the FIDE Classic or Blitz rating. The tournament will not be calculated for FIDE rating.
- 2.4. Deadline for registrations is the **Monday 28<sup>th</sup> of September 2020**

## 3. SYSTEM OF PLAY

---

- 3.1 Round Robin double matches: total 6 rounds. Each team play the others 2 times with opposite colors. Team composition remains stable during all rounds.
- 3.2 Time: 10 min + 2 sec
- 3.3 Tiebreaks  
(a) by the number of board points won, the highest number wins;
- 3.4. The playing server will be announced till end of September.

## 5. FAIR PLAY RULES

---

- 5.1 No other person and no any electronic device allowed in playing room, except the player's PC/Laptop.
- 5.2 Anti-cheating Detection software selected by the ECU

5.3 Players have to download and install ZOOM Client for Meetings from the link below: <https://zoom.us/download>. Players agree to turn on the „Share my Screen” function (in ZOOM) during all games. If a player is not logged into ZOOM chat at the published start time of the match or turns OFF the webcam could result in a loss of the game.

5.4 Streaming from any broadcast platforms including but not limited to Twitch, YouTube or other international platforms is not permitted from participants during their tournament games.

5.5 Organising Committee has the right to change the schedule, update the regulations or decide for any matter that is not mentioned in the current regulations.

5.6 Organising Committee has no any responsibility to technical problems arising to players during the games. Playing server’s policies regarding disconnections, game interruptions and abortions, and anti-cheating instruments are to be followed.

5.7 Arbiters’ decisions in all cases that occur are final, with no option to appeal. Later conclusions from anti-cheating algorithms can change games results and rankings.

## 6. TITLES – PRIZES - QUALIFIERS

---

6.1. The first Team is the Winner of the event and will receive the **Gold medal certificate**

6.2. All the 64 players will receive a **Masterclass** (1.5 hour) **by GM Judit Polgar** in two Groups of 32 players. Date and Time will be announced.

6.3. **Global Chess Festival Certificates** will be available for all participants
