



## Registrations for the European Universities Games 2021

14 – 27 July 2021

Belgrade, Serbia

On the occasion of the 5th edition of the European Universities Games (EUG) which will take place in Belgrade, Serbia from 14 – 27 July 2021, we kindly invite you to participate in the Chess competition.

Chess will be on the [EUG Programme](#) as follows:

**18 July:** Arrival day

**19 July:** GTM (General Technical meeting)

**20 - 23 July:** Competition days

**24 July:** Departure day

Detailed competition schedule will be announced upon the completion of the registrations (Individual Entry).

### REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Participants shall be nominated through their National University Sports Association - NUSA ([EUSA Members](#)), who can submit General Entry Forms via [EUSA Registrations system](#) and define a Contact person (can be athlete or National Chess Federation) to carry out the rest of the registration procedure: Quantitative Entry Form, Individual Entry Forms and Travel Plans. University teams who were already approved by EUSA can continue with the registration procedure.

### REGISTRATION DEADLINES

Due to current pandemic situation, extended registration deadlines can be expected.

General Entry: March 15th

Quantitative Entry: April 15th

Individual Entry: June 15th

Travel Plan: June 15th

### FEES

- Deposit: 200 EUR (deducted from the participation fee once the team is approved)
- Participation Fee: 70 EUR / person / night
- EUSA Entry Fee: 30 EUR / person



Fees cover accommodation with full board – breakfast, lunch, dinner (starting with lunch on arrival and finishing with breakfast on departure day), transfer from official welcome points, local transport, training, competitions, ceremonies and general organization of the event.

#### **PARTICIPANT ELIGIBILITY for EUG2021**

- Students who are officially registered for and pursuing a course of study at: university, or similar institute with the status as an institution of higher education recognised by the appropriate national authority of their country. Participation of university teams from disputed territories is possible only for universities recognised either by the European University Association or the International Association of Universities. Such Universities will compete under University and EUSA flag. A student shall confirm his status by delivering completed, signed and sealed EUSA IEF.
- Former students who obtained their academic degree or diploma after July 31, 2019.
- Competitor's age is defined by the formula: the EUG Year (2021) – competitor's year of birth = age. According to this formula competitor shall not be younger than 17 and older than 31 years.
